New Training Program Registered by the AGRSS Council

The Automotive Glass Replacement Safety Standards (AGRSS) Council has approved a bundle of training modules from the National Glass Association's "My Glass Class" training courses which, when completed together, serve as an AGRSS-registered training program.

"We are pleased NGA's module bundle courses on myglassclass.com have been approved as an AGRSS-registered training program," says Rodger Pickett, AGRSS educational chair. "NGA joins a unique list of companies that have registered their training programs, all of which have distinguished themselves by going through an extensive review process by the AGRSS Council."

In order to register a training program, a company must submit the elements of its training program to the AGRSS Council for review. The Council then reviews to determine if the program complies with the AGRSS Standard.

The program joins a list of five other companies and associations that offer AGRSS-registered training programs:

- Automotive Glass Consultants;
- Dow Automotive;
- Independent Glass Association;
- Shat R Proof Corp.; and
- SIKA Corp.

AGRSS is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to the safe replacement of auto glass. AGRSS was founded and is supported by companies in the auto glass replacement industry that keep safe installation as their primary goal. The Council is also accredited by the American National Standard Institute (ANSI) – a standard development organization – and has developed North America's only auto glass replacement standard, the AGRSS Standard (ANSI/AGRSS 002-2002). The AGRSS Standard addresses procedures, education and product performance.
