JUDGMENT ON JURY VERDICT

This cause came on to be heard on certain dates between January 26 and March 2, 2012, on the complaint of plaintiffs Marion E. Hankins, Peggy D. Hankins, and James F. Hankins against defendant Ford Motor Company.

Having been called for trial, and all parties being present in open court and represented by counsel, and having announced ready for trial upon issue joined, this matter proceeded to trial before a jury of eight (8) good and lawful citizens, both parties having presented evidence and finally rested their case. This matter was presented to the Jury upon instructions by the Court and arguments of counsel. The Jury thereupon retired, deliberated, and returned into open court a verdict in favor of the defendant.

The Court, having received the unanimous verdict of the Jury, finds that Judgment should be entered in favor of the defendant with the plaintiffs taking nothing and dismissing the plaintiffs' complaint with prejudice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that this Judgment be entered in favor of defendant Ford Motor Company, with the plaintiffs to take nothing and with the plaintiffs' complaint being dismissed with prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the parties have twenty-eight (28) days from the entry of this Judgment to file post-trial motions, if any.
