**Freedom Glass Owner Mike Paley
Elected to Auto Glass Safety Council Board**

Mike Paley, president and owner of Freedom Glass in Midlothian, Va., recently was elected to the board of directors of the Auto Glass Safety Council Inc.TM (formerly the AGRSS® Council Inc.).

Freedom Glass is an Auto Glass Safety Council-Registered Company and was the first company ever to complete a successful third-party validation review when the program launched in November 2009.

The AGRSS® Standard addresses procedures, education and product performance for the proper replacement of auto glass.
