This matter comes before the Court upon the parties' submissions regarding the future proceedings necessary in this case in light of the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit's decision vacating the District Court's Order dated March 26, 2013. (ECF Nos. 321, 326, 328, 329). Based on the Court's careful consideration of the parties' positions; and for good cause shown,

IT IS on this 19th day of November, 2015

ORDERED that, on or before December 22, 2015, Plaintiffs shall serve (but not file) their renewed motion for class certification; and it is further

ORDERED that, on or before January 22, 2016, Defendants shall either serve (but not file) their opposition to any renewed class certification motion or, alternatively, Defendants may apply to the Court for limited discovery based solely on Plaintiffs' motion as read in connection with the Court of Appeals' decision. If the Court permits discovery, Defendants shall serve (but not file) any opposition to Plaintiffs' class certification motion within thirty (30) days of the close of such discovery; and it is further

ORDERED that Plaintiffs shall electronically file their renewed motion for class

certication, Defendants' opposition, Plaintiff's reply, and all supporting papers within thirty (30) days of their receipt of Defendants' opposition.
