GLASWELD TRAVELS TO SPAIN TO PRESENT NEW SOLUTIONS AND TRAINING IN GLASS RESTORATION

Glass repair equipment and training options resonate with core markets in the European auto and glass industries

While there, Boyle spoke with some of Spain’s largest auto glass repair companies about the formation of a European Glass Restoration Union, based on his experience on the board of the National Windshield Repair Association in the United States.

GlasWeld plans to return to Spain in the next few weeks to provide training on the Gforce Scratch Removal System to help these large companies save damaged glass and keep it in the supply chain.
