IGA ADDS SEMINAR ABOUT STATE FARM O&A LANGUAGE

The Independent Glass Association (IGA) has added a new seminar to its annual [Independents' Days Conference and Spring Auto Glass Show™](#) to address industry concerns over the latest news concerning changes in the State Farm Offer and Acceptance Program. The seminar will be held Thursday, May 14, at 8:30 a.m.

“We have spent most of the past week addressing concerns from our membership over the new emphasis on certain parts of the State Farm contract language,” stated Dave Zoldowski, IGA president. “We have reviewed all the information we can get our hands on and need to share what we know and think with the membership. We’ve made room in our seminar schedule to discuss this problem.”

On April 9, State Farm released a memorandum to its contracted glass shops indicating that pre-existing policy language discussing glass with insignia, logo, trademark, etching or other markings would now be enforced. State Farm has been invited to participate in the new seminar.

IGA’s Independents’ Days Conference and Spring Auto Glass Show™ will be held May 12-14 at the Sanibel Harbour Resort in Fort Myers, Fla (<http://www.sanibel-resort.com>). The event contains three days of seminars, a two-day trade show and over five hours of IGA auto glass technician certification training and testing.
