PER CURIAM:

IT IS ORDERED that Appellants' emergency opposed motion for stay pending appeal is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this appeal will be scheduled for expedited treatment pursuant to Fifth Circuit Rule 27.5 because otherwise the appeal—which presents an issue of first impression regarding whether the

automatic stay extends to protect Vitro's non-debtor subsidiaries—may be rendered moot by a pending Mexican bankruptcy proceeding.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Appellants' emergency opposed petition for mandamus is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Appellants' motion to file motion for stay pending appeal in excess of the page limitation is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Appellants' motion to file reply to the response to the emergency motion for stay in excess of the page limitation is granted.
